

SAQ in Grimeton, Sweden The Last Pre-electronic Radio Transmitter

SAQ Grimeton operates at 17.2 kHz (VLF) with a 200 kW Alexanderson alternator and a 2.2 km long antenna, using Morse Code. Built in 1922-1924, it is now on the Unesco World Heritage List.



A fully working receiving station will be setup in **Room A** for live "vintage" Morse communication with Grimeton.
